This five-day course is aimed at physicians from around the world who specialise or have a major interest in the care of older people.

Targeting doctors at consultant or senior trainee level, the course includes update lectures by experts on topics of current and practical relevance, with frequent opportunities for interactive case-based learning. Places are limited, thus maximising opportunities for networking. This year we will be focusing on the 'geriatric giants' – mobility, cognition, continence, common comorbidities, and frailty. NB: programme content is the same as 2018!

The course also features a popular social programme, including a Welcome Reception in our historic buildings and a medical history tour of Edinburgh. The afternoons of Wednesday and Friday are free so you can explore our beautiful city.
